

CPCU[®] Designation Scholarship for Corporate Professionals



Scholarship Overview

Each year, The Institutes Designations offers 100 scholarships for the <u>CPCU designation program</u> as a way to encourage continuous learning and the pursuit of professional development. The scholarship covers the cost of:

- · Online CPCU study materials
- · CPCU exam fees
- · Matriculation
- · Waiver fees (for qualifying external coursework)

Scholarship Nominee Qualifications

An organization can select up to two (2) applicants for the CPCU Designation Scholarship. Applicants must be:

- Nominated by a senior executive or senior level manager of an organization with a minimum of five employees
- Engaged or interested in risk management and insurance and able to meet the <u>matriculation requirements</u> for the CPCU designation
- \cdot Able to complete the CPCU program within two (2) years of receiving the scholarship
- \cdot Must be able to start the CPCU program within 30 days of accepting the scholarship

Required Materials

- · Completed application
- · Letter of recommendation from a senior executive or senior level manager within the organization
- · Personal statement answering the question "Why do you want to obtain the CPCU designation?"
- Essay Question: "What do you believe are the most pressing challenges facing the insurance industry today, and how would you approach solving them as a future leader?"

How To Apply

Applicants should complete the <u>Corporate Application</u>, where they will be required to upload their letter of recommendation and personal statement.

We will be reviewing applications as we receive them. Applications open the first day of March.
